

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

January 12, 2015

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George H. Gornito.

Invocation was led by Councilman Tanner followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Young and seconded by Councilman Williams to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to approve the bills was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Tanner. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Young to add the following two items to the agenda:

Police Camera Equipment  
Alcohol License Transfer – Flash Foods

All voted to add the two items with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Brown to accept the bid from L3 Mobile-Vision in the amount of \$7,356 for the purchase of new police camera equipment. All voted in favor with none opposed.

City Administrator Larry Drew presented the information on the alcohol license transfer for Flash Foods manager, Pauline Andrews. After discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Young and seconded by Councilman Williams to approve the transfer of alcohol license to Pauline Lewis. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to amend the 2013-2014 budget per the 6/30/14 audit was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Tanner. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Young to set the election qualifying fees for the 2015 General Election as follows:

Mayor: \$288.00  
Council Member: \$108.00

All voted in favor of the election qualifying fees with none opposed.

A motion to adopt the revised Water Conservation Plan was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Williams. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Tanner to give the City employees a 2% cost of living adjustment. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Young to set aside \$20,000 of SPLOST funds in order to pay engineers Hofstadter and Associates to upgrade the sewer system permit capacity from 750,000 gallons to 2,000,000 gallons to comply with EPD requirements. All voted in favor with none opposed.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Young. All voted in favor with none opposed.
