

THE CALLED MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

October 19, 2015

The called meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George H. Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Brown followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Young to approve the amended minutes of September 14, 2015 and the regular meeting minutes of October 12, 2015. All voted in favor with none opposed.

The public hearing on the proposed 2015 Ad Valorem Tax Millage Rate was opened. No one was present to speak in favor or against the proposed millage; therefore, the hearing was closed. After discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Brown to set the 2015 tax millage rate at 4.096 mills. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)

A motion was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Young to accept the bid from Akins Ford Dodge in the amount of \$28,793.64 for the purchase of a 2015 Dodge Charger Pursuit Vehicle for the Police Department. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Tanner. All voted in favor with none opposed.
