

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

June 13, 2016

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George H. Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Brown followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Young to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to approve the bills was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Brown. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to add "Harrow Bid" to the agenda was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Young. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to approve the bid for a harrow in the amount of \$2,000 from Tommy Wood for the water department and to be purchased with SPLOST funds was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Brown.

The public hearing on the proposed 2016-2017 budget was opened. No one spoke in favor or against the proposed budget; therefore, the hearing was closed. A motion to adopt the proposed 2016-2017 budget was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Brown. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)

A motion was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Young to adopt the 2015-2016 amended budget. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)

A motion was made by Councilman Young and seconded by Councilman Jackson to approve the bid from Grosch Drilling Co in the amount of \$8,338.00 for an upgraded motor for the backup wells and to be purchased with SPLOST funds. All voted in favor with none opposed.

The Mayor and Council held the first reading of the utility rate increases. Mayor Gornto advised the Council that the new rates for commercial garbage services were not yet determined, but, would be ready by next month's meeting. It was discussed and agreed to hold the second reading and adoption of the utility rate increases, along with the commercial garbage rate increases, at the next regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council in July.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Young. All voted in favor with none opposed.
