

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

July 10, 2017

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor Pro Tem Len Tanner.

Invocation was led by Councilman Brown followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Williams to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to approve the bills was made by Councilman Young and seconded by Councilman Jackson. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve closing 235 feet of Taylor Lane once a survey has been done and the City Attorney has drawn up the legal document and had it recorded. Councilman Brown, Councilman Jackson and Councilman Young voted in favor of the closure and Councilman Williams abstained from voting.

Carey Washington of 201 Jackson Street, East Dublin addressed the Council during pre-council time with complaints of the vacant lot next to him being overgrown and needing to be cleaned up. City Administrator Larry Drew advised Mr. Washington that the City will send a certified letter to the property owners advising them they need to take care of the property.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Williams. All voted in favor with none opposed.
