

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

September 18, 2017

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Brown followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Young to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to approve the bills was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Brown.. All voted in favor with none opposed.

There were no additions or deletions to the agenda.

Mayor Gornto advised the Council that the Fire Department received a grant from FEMA in the amount of \$59,048 for the purchase of 20 air pack bottles for the department. He advised that the grant requires the City to match some of the cost and therefore the City will use SPLOST funds to pay for the remaining balance of the cost of the air pack bottles.

Three bids for the purchase of the 20 air pack bottles for the Fire Department were presented and they are as follows:

After discussion, a motion to accept the lowest bid from American Safety & Fire in the amount of \$62,500 was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Young. All voted in favor with none opposed.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Brown. All voted in favor with none opposed.
