

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

November 13, 2017

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George Gornito.

Invocation was led by Councilman Brown followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Young to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to approve the bills was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Tanner. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Brown to add to the agenda two items: "Soft Starter Bids" and "Police Antenna Repair". All voted in favor with none opposed

A motion was made by Councilman Young and seconded by Councilman Brown to accept the bid from GMA-GIRMA for the Firefighters' Cancer Benefit Program in the amount of \$672.00 per year. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached List)

A motion to give the employees of the City a Christmas Bonus was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Tanner. All voted in favor of the bonuses with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)

Bids were presented to the Council for the purchase of a new soft starter and rebuilt soft starter for the sewer lift stations. There are as follows:

After discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Jackson to purchase a rebuilt soft-starter from Calibration Control for \$1,902.11 and a new soft-starter from Mullis Electrical Supply for \$3,295.00. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Copies)

A motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Brown to accept the bid from Macon Communication for the repair of the police antenna in the amount of \$1,894.36. The motion also included moving the antenna from the top of the well located at the old city hall property to the Laurens County Courthouse. All voted in favor with none opposed.

Albert McClendon of 607 Jordan Street, East Dublin, addressed the Mayor and Council during pre-council concerning a pot hole on Jordan Street.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Young. All voted in favor with none opposed.
