December 11, 2017

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George H. Gornito.

Invocation was led by Councilman Brown followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Williams to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to approve the bills was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Young. All voted in favor with none opposed.

Nirav Patel with Oconee Package Shop addressed the Mayor and Council during Pre-Council with a request to have the City ordinance of no alcohol sales on Christmas day be changed to where it would be lawful in East Dublin to sell alcohol on Christmas Day. Mayor Gornto advised Mr. Patel that the City did not have enough time, due to advertisement requirements, to make the ordinance change for this year, but, would look into making the change for the next year.

Mayor Gornto and Council congratulated Larry Drew on his upcoming retirement from the City at the end of December. Mayor Gornto and Council expressed their sad but happy gratitude to Larry for his 41 years of dedicated service to the City of East Dublin.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Williams. All voted in favor with none opposed.
