

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

March 12, 2018

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George H. Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Tanner followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Jackson to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to approve the bills was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Brown. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to add to the agenda "City Attorney" was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Jackson. All voted in favor with none opposed.

City Attorney Emily Kight presented to the Mayor and Council her resignation as city attorney to be effective 3/31/2018. After discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Williams to accept the resignation of City Attorney Emily Kight. All voted in favor with none opposed. A public hearing was held on the Alcohol Ordinance Amendment # 18-01. No one was present to speak in favor or against the amendment; therefore, the public hearing was closed. A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Jackson to approve the amendment that will legalize the sale of alcohol on Christmas Day unless Christmas Day falls on a Sunday. Two Councilmembers voted to approve with two Councilmembers voted against the amendment. Mayor Gornto cast the tie-breaker vote to approve the amendment. (See Attached Copy)

A motion was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Jackson to surplus the 2006 Keystone Camper and be advertised on GovDeals.com. All voted in favor with none opposed.

Bids for a new mosquito sprayer were presented to the Mayor and Council. After discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Williams to accept the low bid of \$8,200.00 from Adapco. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Copies)

A motion was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Jackson to authorize City Clerk Melissa Bassett to close the Employee Benefit Plan Bank Account at Capital City Bank and deposit the remaining funds in to the General Fund located with the Bank of Dudley. All voted in favor with none opposed.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Williams. All voted in favor with none opposed.
