

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

May 14, 2018

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George H. Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Tanner followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Williams to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to approve the bills was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Jackson. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Brown to table the "Citation Amendment" item until next regular meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Williams to adopt the following fees for the use of the Buckeye Park, Community House and Gazebo. All voted in favor with none opposed.
