

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

August 13, 2018

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George H. Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Brown followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Williams to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to approve the bills was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Braxton. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Braxton and seconded by Councilman Jackson to add "Falcons Landing Sewer" to the agenda. All voted in favor with none approved.

Mayor Gornto presented to the Council a request from Dwayne Edge, property owner of Falcons Landing, to tie onto the City's sewer service line in order that his property would have City sewer. After discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Tanner to allow Dwayne Edge to tie his Falcons Landing property to city sewer with the stipulation that Mr. Edge pay a sewer tap fee, incur all cost of installation and install the sewer service lines inside the subdivision to the City of East Dublin's specifications. Once installed, Mr. Edge will be responsible for any and all maintenance of sewer system within the subdivision. Once installed, the billing of sewer and water service to Falcons Landing will be set up as a multiple user with outside city residential rates. All voted in favor of these provisions with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Williams to amend the 2018-2019 SPLOST budget by adding \$20,000 for new floors, new lights and painting for City Hall. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)

Bids for a 2019 Chevy Tahoe to be purchased for the Police Department were presented. After discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Jackson to accept the lowest bid of \$35,962.31 from Hardy Automotive. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Bids)

The first reading of the Sewer Ordinance amendment was held. It was noted that the Sewer Ordinance amendment will be voted on at the next regular meeting.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Jackson and seconded by Councilman Williams. All voted in favor with none opposed.
