

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

December 10, 2018

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George H. Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Brown followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Tanner to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to approve the bills was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Williams. All voted in favor with none opposed.

Bids for police equipment were presented as follows:

Axon Enterprise, Inc.:	2 Tasers	\$2,290.00
Watch Guard:	7 Body Cameras	\$6,370.00

During discussion of the bids, Mayor Gornto ask the Council to add \$700 to the police equipment bids in order to de-stripe, add new lights and siren the 2014 Dodge Charger to be used as an extra vehicle for the police department. Mayor Gornto also stated that this vehicle can also be used by employees to travel for training purposes instead of using their personal vehicles.

After discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve the bids for police equipment along with the additional \$700. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Tanner to surplus the leaf vacuum and mosquito sprayer in the public works department and to place each item on govdeals.com. All voted in favor with none opposed.

The new alcohol license application for packaged beer and wine for Lisa Sorrow for Flash Foods located at 405 Soperton Avenue was presented to the Mayor and Council. After discussion, a motion to approve the new license was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Brown. All voted in favor with none opposed.

After discussion, a motion to approve the renewal of all alcohol licenses listed for the year 2019 was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Tanner. All voted in favor with none opposed.

Bids for sewer equipment were presented as follows:

Mayor Gornto advised Council that the ELS lift station was damaged during Hurricane Michael and will be included in the FEMA claim. After discussion, a motion to approve sewer equipment bids was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Brown. All voted in favor with none opposed.

Mayor and Council held the first reading of Ordinance # 2018-03 of the amendment of Chapter 2 of the City Ordinances. Once recommended changes are made, Ordinance # 2018-03 will be presented at the next regular council meeting for adoption.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Brown. All voted in favor with none opposed.
