City of East Dublin Closed to the Public

The City of East Dublin will discontinue all in-person services and programs as we seek to prevent the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 – COVID-19. This will be effective Thursday, March 19, 2020, until further notice. Specifically, these include the renting of the East Dublin Community House as well as the Catfish Tournament. All City facilities, including City Hall, will remain closed to the public until further notice.

Essential employees, including Clerk's Office, Streets/Public Works and Water/Sewer personnel, will report to work as scheduled. They will be available via phone or email to answer any questions or provide assistance regarding payments as well as obtaining forms, information etc. For your convenience for making utility payments, you can visit the City's website for online payments and there is a drop box available in the drive-thru.

Our drive-thru will be open for business. Monday – Friday 8:00 am – 5:00 pm

Following recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, we encourage those who are at highest risk of contracting the virus – including older residents, those with underlying health issues and compromised immune systems – to please stay at home.
