

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

March 9, 2020

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Tanner followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Sheppard and seconded by Councilman Williams to approve the minutes as read of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to approve the bills was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Tanner. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Sheppard to approve the financial statements along with a hotel/motel financial statement. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Roberson and seconded by Councilman Williams to adopt the Fixed Asset Capitalization Policy Resolution. All voted in favor with none opposed.

At this time Mayor Gornto called Councilman Brown and Mark Tarpley to the front to recognize Mark's thirty-two years of service to the City of East Dublin Fire Department. Councilman Brown presented Mark with a plaque to commemorate his service to East Dublin.

Mayor Gornto introduced the new Fire Chief, Phil Bracewell.

Mildred Jackson of 330 Branham Street, East Dublin, addressed the Mayor and Council with concerns about what was recorded in the minutes a few months ago concerning the entrances to the new Hilton Properties on Soperton Avenue. She expressed concerns that the minutes did not address that there would be an entrance/exit on Oakwood Drive. She also had concerns about the minutes from the Zoning Board meeting that was held in December. She stated that the minutes from the Zoning Board meeting showed that she was present at the meeting when she says she was not present. Mayor Gornto and Council stated that they would look into these matters and address them as needed.

Artiffany Stanley, Member Services Consultant with the Georgia Municipal Associations, addressed the Mayor and Council stating that she was now the liaison for Districts 6 & 9 and that she was available to help the City with anything that they may need her help on. Mayor Gornto and Council thanked her for coming and stated that the City will call on her if needed.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Sheppard and seconded by Councilwoman Roberson. All voted in favor with none opposed.
