

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

May 11, 2020

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Tanner followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilwoman Roberson to approve the minutes as read of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Sheppard to approve the financial statement. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to approve up to \$30,000.00 for Well #3 Repairs was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Tanner. All voted in favor with none opposed.

The first reading of Ordinance # 2020-01 and Ordinance 2020-02 was held and it was agreed to have the final reading and adoption of each ordinance at the next regular meeting to be held in June.

During Recognition of Citizens, Rosie Jackson of 304 West Drive, East Dublin, addressed the Mayor and Council with complaints about loud music in her neighborhood. Mayor Gornto called on Police Chief Bill Luecke to check into the situation.

Also during Recognition of Citizens, Thomas Judd and Miscile Jorgensen of 200 Corbett Street, East Dublin and managers of Ponderosa Mobile Home Park in East Dublin addressed the Mayor and Council about getting the City's help in applying for a sanitary sewer grant in order to install city sewer to a new part of the mobile home park. Mr. Judd explained that the new section that they wanted to add was accessible to city water, but, not city sewer and he asked for the City's help in possibly applying for a grant to help with the cost of installing sewer lines to the area. Mayor Gornto advised him that the City will look into the situation and get in contact with him. Mayor Gornto asked that Mr. Judd give his contact information to City Clerk Melissa Bassett.

Miscile Jorgensen then asked the Mayor and Council about the smallest square footage that the City allows for homes. Mayor Gornto asked Police Chief Bill Luecke what the minimum square footage was and he said it was 1,000 sq. ft.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Brown. All voted in favor with none opposed.
