

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

September 14, 2020

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Tanner followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Sheppard to approve the minutes as read of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilwoman Roberson to approve the bills. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Sheppard to approve the financial statement along with the adjustments made to the water and sewer. All voted in favor with none opposed.

The public hearing on the proposed 2020 Ad Valorem Tax Millage Rate was opened. No one present spoke in favor or against the proposed millage rate; therefore, the hearing was closed. After discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Sheppard to set the 2020 Ad Valorem Tax Millage Rate at 4.070 mills. All voted in favor with none opposed. A motion was made by Councilwoman Roberson and seconded by Councilman Williams to approve the Automatic Aid Resolution. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)
