

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

August 16, 2021

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Tanner followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve the minutes as read of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilwoman Roberson to approve the bills. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Sheppard to approve the financial statement. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to add to the agenda "Employee Benefits" was made by Councilwoman Roberson and seconded by Councilman Williams. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Roberson and seconded by Councilman Williams to approve an increase in the basic employee life insurance benefit from \$15,000 to \$30,000. All voted in favor with none opposed.

Bids for a lawnmower trailer for the public works department were presented to the Council and they are as follows:
