

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

October 11, 2021

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Tanner followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Roberson and seconded by Councilman Sheppard to approve the minutes as read of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve the bills. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilwoman Roberson to approve the financial statement. All voted in favor with none opposed.

The public hearing on the proposed 2021 Ad Valorem Tax Millage Rate was opened. No one present spoke in favor or against the proposed millage rate; therefore, the hearing was closed. After discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Sheppard and seconded by Councilman Tanner to set the 2021 Ad Valorem Tax Millage Rate at 4.070 mills. All voted in favor with none opposed. The proposed American Rescue Plan Act budget was presented to the Council. After discussion, a motion was made by Councilwoman Roberson and seconded by Councilman Brown to adopt the proposed American Rescue Plan Act budget. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)

A motion was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Tanner to approve the State Fiscal Recovery Fund Application Resolution. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)

During "Recognition of Citizens", Rhonda Baker of 403 Damon Street, East Dublin, addressed the Mayor and Council about loud music in her neighborhood. She told the council that the music is coming from 305 Crestview Drive and the person living there has large speakers turned toward their pool every weekend and the music is carrying throughout the neighborhood after midnight and later. She has called 911 numerous times and the issue has yet to be resolved. Mayor Gornto and Council asked Police Chief Bill Luecke to talk with the residents at 305 Crestview and tell them to keep the music low and then turn it off at 10 p.m.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Sheppard. All voted in favor with none opposed.
