

CHAPTER 19

STREETS AND SIDEWALKS

Sec. 19-1. Objects obstructing streets.

No person shall place or cause to be placed on any public street, highway or roadway within the corporate limits of the city any object or objects of sufficient size that obstruct wholly or partially any such public street, highway or roadway or interfere with the free flow of travel on such public street, highway or roadway, or which render travel on such public street, highway or roadway less safe, without the written permission of the mayor and council.

Sec. 19-2. Prisoners - To comprise work force; supervision.

There shall be a work force, composed of all offenders against the laws of the city sentenced to compulsory labor upon the public works of the city or other persons or convicts turned over to the city in accordance with any law of the city or the state to be put at compulsory labor. The work force shall be in the charge of the chief of police and such policemen or other guards as may be provided. (Ord of 12-11-72, Ch. IX, {26)

Sec. 19-3. Same - Talking to while at work.

No person shall talk to or communicate with any convict placed at compulsory labor while on the public works without permission of the person in charge of such convict.

Sec. 19-4. Telephone and Telegraph Wires, Cables and Conduits.

- (1) It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, except a franchisee, to place a telephone or telegraph wire, cable or conduit upon, under or above the right-of-way of a city street or streets without first having obtained from the City Engineer a permit to do so. This permit, if granted by the City Engineer, shall be in duplicate, specifying the name of the street(s) involved, the purpose for which the wire, cable or conduit is run, the type and length of wire, cable or conduit to be run, the extent of the construction to be performed, and the time allowed for performance of the work.
- (2) All permits issued hereunder shall be valid for one year from the date of issuance. The permit shall be renewable annually as long as the person, firm or corporation desires to maintain the wire, cable or conduit upon, under or above the right-of-way of the street(s) involved.
- (3) The fee for said permit shall be two dollars (\$2.00) per foot of wire, cable or conduit occupying said street(s) per year.
- (4) The installation of said telephone or telegraph wires, cables or conduits shall be done by a

licensed contractor and said work shall be done in a workmanlike manner in accordance with any specifications provided in regulations adopted by the City Engineer.

- (5) Any person, firm or corporation who is installing an overhead wire or cable across a city street shall at all times maintain a minimum eighteen foot (18') clearance above the surface of said street(s).
- (6) Any person, firm or corporation who is installing an underground wire, cable or conduit requiring said permit shall also comply with all other provisions of the Code which deals with excavations into a public street.
- (7) The permit issued above shall also specify that the permittee shall at all times be responsible to the public and hold the City of East Dublin harmless for any property damage or personal injury caused or occasioned by the installation, maintenance or occupancy of any wire, cable or conduit under, upon or above a street right-of-way as permitted herein.
- (8) The City Engineer shall be authorized to require a permittee hereunder to relocate their wire, cable or conduit in the event such relocation is a public necessity. The City Engineer may also require an overhead wire or cable to be relocated underground if the street(s) involved should convert from an overhead telephone system to an underground telephone system. Permission is hereby granted to _____ to make excavation/or aerial occupancy into right-of-way of the street(s) shown on reverse side, at the rate of two dollars (\$2.00) per foot of wire, cable, or conduit occupying said street, per year. This permit is valid for one (1) year from date of issue and shall be void unless renewed before void date. Above amount is to be made payable to the City of East Dublin, for correct amount on the day this permit application is requested and a full listing of total footage, including a complete plan of said installation is to be submitted to the City Engineer for application to verify distance requirement under Chapter 19, Section 19-4 (1) thru 19-4 (8), of the City of East Dublin Code of Ordinances.

Applicant agrees, at its own expense, to defend, indemnify, save and hold the City of East Dublin harmless from and against all liabilities, judgments, costs, damages, and expenses which might accrue against, be charged to or recovered from the City of East Dublin by reason or on account of any property damage or personal injury caused or occasioned by the installation, maintenance or occupancy of any wire, cable, or conduit under, upon or above a street right-of-way as permitted herein.

CAUTION All conduit, wires, telephone and telegraph wires, cable, etc., placed overhead on any right-of-way at all times shall maintain a minimum 18-foot clearance above surface of said

road or street. Before digging in right-of-way, call utility companies for buried cable, water services, or mains, gas lines; and City Engineer's Office for traffic detector loops in right-of-way. It shall be the responsibility of the applicant to maintain any paving cut until patched by the City of East Dublin Public Works Department unless permission is obtained from Public Works Department for said utility to do their own repair of paving cuts in which case it would be the responsibility of applicant to have satisfactorily completed said paving with approval of same from City Engineer's Office.
