

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

November 14, 2022

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Brown followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Roberson and seconded by Councilman Tanner to approve as read the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Sheppard to approve the financial statements. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Tanner to approve \$85,000 of ARPA funds for the purchase and installation of a generator for the water department that will be used to run both wells at the same time in case of a power outage. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to give the employees of the City a Christmas Bonus was made by Councilman Sheppard and seconded by Councilman Williams. All voted in favor of the bonuses with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)

At this time Mayor Gornto opened the floor for Recognition of Citizens.

Early Clover of 406 Attaway Street, East Dublin, addressed the Mayor and Council with a commendation of the improvements done at the Buckeye Park with the installation of the walking track. He then requested that bathroom facilities be installed near the track. Mayor Gornto advised Mr. Clover that there was a concession stand with bathroom facilities to be constructed in the near future.

At this time Mayor Gornto opened the floor for Council Comments.

Councilman Brown stated the he saw that there was a need for lighting to be installed at the walking track and a fence or some type of barrier to keep vehicles off the walking track. It was discussed and agreed upon that the City would place a light pole with sufficient lighting in the center of the track and would check into installing a barrier at the track.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Sheppard. All voted in favor with none opposed.
