

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

December 12, 2022

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Tanner followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilwoman Roberson to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as read. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve the bills to be paid. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Roberson and seconded by Councilman Sheppard to approve the financial statements. All voted in favor with none opposed.
