

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

March 13, 2023

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Brown followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Tanner to approve the minutes as read of the previous regular meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Sheppard to approve the bills for payment. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Roberson and seconded by Councilman Tanner to approve the financial statements. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to surplus the 2013 Ford Expedition in the Police Department and place on GovDeals.com for auction with a minimum bid of \$10,000.00 was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Williams. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve the quote for sewer lift station repairs for the Highway 319 sewer lift station in the amount of 14,483.23. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Sheppard to adopt the Amended Redistricting Resolution. It was noted that the proposed district map that shows 42 people will be moved from District #2 to District #1 to comply with the 5.0% variance rule. It was also noted that District #3 with a 1.8% variance was in the 5.0% variance rule and was not changed. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)
