

## THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

November 13, 2023

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Brown followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Roberson and seconded by Councilman Williams to amend paragraph eight of the minutes of the previous meeting by changing the amount of the bid approved for the two trucks to \$34,525.00. The motion also included that the minutes of the previous meeting will be approved once the amendment was made. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Sheppard to approve the bills for payment. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve the financial statements. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and Councilwoman Roberson to surplus and sell on GovDeals.com, a 2008 Ford F150 truck and a 2012 Ford F150 truck in the water department. All voted in favor with none opposed.

Two ordinances were presented to the Council. Ordinance 23-01 will amend the Zoning Map to correct the zoning area of the Long Pines Subdivision from R1-A to R1 and Ordinance 23-02 will amend the street width of District R4 from 100 feet to 75 feet. After discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve both Ordinance 23-01 and Ordinance 23-02. All voted in favor with none opposed. A motion was made by Councilwoman Roberson and seconded by Councilman Tanner to approve the Georgia Environmental Finance Authority (GEFA) Resolution that will authorize the City of East Dublin borrow funds from GEFA to help fund the Lead & Copper Service Line Project. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)

A motion to give the employees of the City a Christmas Bonus with the addition of adding James Taylor to the list was made by Councilman Sheppard and seconded by Councilwoman Roberson. All voted in favor of the bonuses with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Sheppard. All voted in favor with none opposed.
