

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

May 13, 2024

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Tanner followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilwoman Roberson to approve the minutes as read of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to add to the agenda “Teledyne Isco Invoice” was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Tanner. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Sheppard to approve the bills for payment, which included the invoice from Teledyne Isco. All voted in favor with none opposed

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve the financial statements. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Roberson and seconded by Councilman Sheppard to approve the Watershed Protection Plan 2023 Annual Report. All voted in favor with none opposed.

The proposed rate changes for water meters and street bores were presented to the Council. After discussion of the proposed changes, a motion to approve the proposed rate changes for water meters and street bores was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilwoman Roberson. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)

The bids for the Holmes Drive Lift Station Repairs were presented to the Council as follows:

Xylem Water Solutions	\$4,025.38
Pro Pump Solutions	\$6,464.00

After discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve the bid from Xylem Water Solutions in the amount of \$4,025.38. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A letter from Evans Disposal requesting an extension to the current contract with the City for garbage services was presented to the Council. After discussion, a motion to approve the contract extension was made by Councilwoman Roberson and seconded by Councilman Brown. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Copy of Letter)

A motion was made by Councilman Sheppard and seconded by Councilman Tanner to approve the purchase of three (3) aerators for the wastewater treatment pond in the amount of \$5,500.00 each. All voted in favor with none opposed.

At this time Mayor Gornto opened the floor for Recognition of Citizens.

Ruben Baldwin of 204 Jackson Street, East Dublin addressed the Mayor and Council with a question about if the city had a full crew of police officers. He stated that he has not seen police patrol his neighborhood in about a year. Mayor Gornto stated that the city now has a full crew of officers at this time.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Tanner. All voted in favor with none opposed.
