

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

April 8, 2019

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George H. Gornito.

Invocation was led by Councilman Tanner followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to approve the bills was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Williams. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Williams to approve the financial statements. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve the resolution calling for a Special Election to be held on November 5, 2019 to fill two vacant seats on City Council due to the untimely deaths of District 3 Councilman Zilmon Young and At-Large Councilman Dent Jackson, Jr. All voted in favor of the resolution with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Brown to adopt the proclamation designating May 1st as “Dent Jackson, Jr. Day” in memorial to Councilman Dent Jackson, Jr. All voted in favor with none opposed.

After discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Williams to approve the above listed expenditures. All voted in favor with none opposed.

During “Recognition of Citizens”, William Henderson of 605 Jordan Street, East Dublin,

addressed the Mayor and Council with concerns about loud music and drugs being sold at the Dublin Housing Authority Apartments located on Jordan Street near his home. Mayor Gornto advised Mr. Henderson that Police Chief Bill Luecke was working with the Dublin Housing Authority to address the issue and that East Dublin Council would look into its Loitering Ordinance to see if there was a way to tighten up on the loitering at the apartment complex. Chief Luecke also stated that he would talk with Georgia Power about placing video cameras in the area to help with these issues.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Tanner. All voted in favor with none opposed.
