

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

July 8, 2019

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George H. Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Tanner followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to approve the bills was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Tanner. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Williams to approve the financial statements. All voted in favor with none opposed.

The bids for water tank maintenance contract are as follows:

American Tank	\$24,201 / year

After discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve the lowest bid from American Tank for \$24,201 per year. All voted in favor with none opposed.

He wanted to recognize three East Laurens Middle and High School students for their participation a reading program that was held at the Warnock Ball Park.
