

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EAST DUBLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL

November 11, 2019

The regular meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor George Gornto.

Invocation was led by Councilman Tanner followed by pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve, as read, the minutes of the 10/14/2019 Regular Meeting and the 10/29/2019 Called Meeting. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion to approve the bills was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Williams. All voted in favor with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Tanner to approve the financial statements. All voted in favor with none opposed.

In the 12/16/2019 Regular Meeting of the East Dublin Mayor and Council, a motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Brown to amend and approve the 11/11/2019 minutes after adding and approving the Service Delivery Strategy Resolution. All voted with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Brown to add to the agenda "Hilton Properties". All voted in favor for the addition with none opposed.

A motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve to run water and sewer service to Hilton Properties located at 530 Soperton Road. The motion also included that the project would be funded with SPLOST funds. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached Letter and Map)

A motion was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Williams to accept the results of the November 5, 2019 General Election as certified by Election Superintendent, Ginger Boland. All voted with none opposed. (See Attached Consolidated Election Returns)

A list of personal property taxes to be written off was presented to the Mayor and Council. After discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Tanner and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve to write off the listed taxes. All voted in favor with none opposed. (See Attached List)

A motion to give the employees of the City a Christmas Bonus was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Tanner. All voted in favor of the bonuses with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)

A motion was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Brown to approve the first reading of the Charter amendments with the changes noted and to present the

amendments at the next regular meeting scheduled to be held on December 9, 2019. All voted with favor with none opposed. (See Attached Copy)

Mildred Jackson addressed the Mayor and Council concerning her health insurance that she currently has with the City through her late husband and Council Member Dent Jackson. City Clerk Melissa Bassett advised Mrs. Jackson to speak with Marcus Clements, the insurance agent that handled her initial enrollment, saying that he is already aware that Mrs. Jackson will be losing her coverage on 12/31/2019 and that he is available to help her with any changes she needs to make in order to switch the coverage over to her.

Mrs. Jackson also advised the Council that the area where the sewer service lines were installed at the corner of Railroad Ave. and Carol Dr. has caved in again. Mayor Gornto stated that the City will have Public Works check on the area and see what needs to be done to make the necessary repairs.

Carolyn Norris addressed the Council with a thank you for the new speed limit signs along Attaway Street.

Brenda Roberson addressed the Council with concerns about speeders on Jordan Street. Mayor Gornto advised Ms. Roberson that Police Chief Bill Luecke will have the police department increase patrol in the area.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Williams and seconded by Councilman Tanner. All voted in favor with none opposed.
